



# Package 1

### DAY 3: KAKHETI - WINE REGION (B/L/-)

After breakfast drive to **Kakheti — wine region**, first we will visit **Gighnaghi** - Medieval city in the southern part of Georgia, settled since the Paleolithic period. Now it is called the city of love, with many couples going there just to get married. The town was developed (over earlier ruins) in the 18th century by King ErekleTI. The town has wonderful views of the Alazani valley and the Caucasus beyond. The main section of the 18th-century wall runs along the town.

Afterwards drive to **Bodbemonastery**, it is one of the major pilgrimage sites in Georgia, due to its association with **St. Nino, a woman who preached Christianity in Georgia in 4thC**. She is buried in the Monastery.

Continue to a **local family house to have a masterclass to learn how to make Georgian sweets - Churchkhela**, then have a home-made lunch, after that drive to visit **Tsinandali** house museum of aristocratic poet Aleksander Chavchavadze, he built the Palace and designed the surrounding gardens, set the biggest wineries.

Tour of the museum and wine tasting. Gurvey the place and drive in the direction of the main city of Kakheti - Telavi, check in and have free evening.

Overnight in Telavi.





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## DAY 4: GEORGIA - WINEMAKING UNIQUE TRADITIONS (B/L/-)

After breakfast drive to visit a **museum of wine jars** and the studio where you can see the masterpiece of wine -jar making. **Georgia is the oldest wine region in the world**, wine production already counts 8000 years.

In 2013, UNESCO added the ancient traditional Georgian winemaking method using the Quevri, clay jars, to the UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage List.

After having been introduced to the winemaking tradition, drive to **Twins wine** cellar, have a wine tour and participate in **baking Georgian bread**. Have lunch and taste some sorts of finest Georgian wines. Enjoy one more hour in this wonderful place and drive to Tbilisi, check into a hotel and have a free evening.

Overnight in Tbilisi.





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#### DAY 5: MTSKHETA - ANCIENT CAPITAL (B/-/D)

After breakfast drive to Mtskheta -ancient capital and spiritual center of Georgia, it was a capital of the early Georgian Kingdom of Iberia from the 3rd century BC to the 5th century AD. It was a site of early Christian activity resulting in Christianization of Iberia, where Christianity was proclaimed the state religion in 337. Visit Svetitskhoveli Cathedral — the present structure was completed in the 11th C. although the site itself dates back to the early fourth century. Afterwards drive to visit Jvari Monastery (6th c.) situated on the top of a hill opening a fascinating view of the city. The entire city is in the list of UNESCO heritage sites. Continue to drive along the Georgian military road to the north, few stops: Ananuri Complex, a castle of local feudal dynasty and a perfect spot for photo shooting in Gudauri ski resort. Arrive to Kazbegi region — high Caucasus and have a free evening. Dinner at the hotel. Overnight in Kazbegi.

#### DAY 6: KAZBEGI - HIGH CAUCASUS (B/L/-)

After breakfast start off road jeep tour, drive up to Gergeti Trinity Church, built in 14thC. The church is situated on the top of the mount, then drive to Gweleti waterfall, I hour trekking to reach the site. During lunchtime visit a local family, where you can have some rest and take in preparing a famous Georgian dish – Khinkali (Georgian dumplings), have lunch and taste some local traditional dishes. Continue to Truso Valley, the source of Tegri River is quite a mystical and spectacular place, worth hitchhiking and hiking if you happen to be in Kazbegi for more than a day. Truso valley is known for its mineral water springs, white/yellow travertines, a mineral lake with bubbles, towers of middle ages, most notably, the Zakagori Castle, villages on a very high altitude such as Resi (2350m). Upon return from the valley, back to the hotel and overnight.

Overnight in Kazbegi.











### DAY 7: TBILISI - FAREWELL DAY (B/-/D)

After breakfast drive further to **Uplistsikhe - literally, "the lord's fortress"**, in the VI-V centuries BC it was one of the most important cultural-political centers of Kartli Kingdom, and from the TI century BC it became a typical Hellenistic town. Uplistsikhe was the important trading center and a flourishing town on the Gilk Way. Afterwards visit **Joseph Stalin's hometown – Gori**, visit also the Museum of Stalin, finally, Continue to Tbilisi, check into the hotel and have some rest.

At 20:00 h Farewell **Gala dinner** at a traditional Georgian restaurant with **folk show**—Georgian songs and dances, which are quite unique in the world, **Overnight in Tbilisi.**
